For men:

Underwear must never be seen Pants and shorts must not be worn too low Shirts must be worn at all times Tattoos and body piercings must not be visible Ads or other references to drugs, tobacco, or alcohol products, inappropriate language or phrases are prohibited

Swimwear: please wear a t-shirt with long swim trunks

For women:

Undergarments must never be seen

No see-through material

Clothing must not be too tight in any area – tights/leggings are not pants, and must be covered with a skirt or shorts

Neck lines must be no lower than 4 fingers below the collar bone, cleavage must never be seen No tank tops, spaghetti straps, halter tops, strapless tops, strappy or missing backs
